# Paint Protection Film (PPF)

Paint protection film (also called Clear Bra) is:

- Made of urethane
- Approximately 8 mils thick (.008 inches)

#### It protects against:

- 🗓 Dirt, gravel and debris
- $^{\prime\prime}$  Scratches and chips
- Offers some UV protection

\*Hard water and bird droppings can etch or erode film





### Clear Bra (PPF) benefits:

- 💥 Relatively low maintenance
- Possible lifespan between 7 and 10 years
- ♦ Can be combined ceramic coating for maximum protection

# **Ceramic Coating**

Ceramic Coating is a liquid paint protector that:

- Is made of nano-ceramic liquid polymers
- Functions as a super hydrophobic protective clear coat

- Allows for 3x the washing and drying before any marring occurs
- Increases surface tension which minimizes surface pores and lessens adhesion of debris
