



CAR WAX VS CAR SEALANT VS CERAMIC COATING

CAR WAX

A liquid or hard paste comprised primarily of beeswax, carnauba wax, petroleum distillates and natural oils. Wax provides one to four months of exterior paint protection while enhancing shine and gloss. Application longevity depends on quality of product.

CAR SEALANTS

This mid-tier protection solution provides some additional protection against UV damage and pollutants/contaminants that can damage vehicle paint. Sealant generally lasts longer than wax (up to six months), makes washing and drying easier and enhances gloss.

CERAMIC COATING

Ceramic coating features many attributes similar to sealant and wax at an enhanced level and with longer duration. Ceramic coatings make it easier to wash a car and provides some protection against swirl marks (extremely fine scratches) and paint damage.

DRAWBACKS

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be reapplied frequently • Wax should be stripped before reapplication • Frequent reapplications can be expensive • Doesn't provide same pollutant or scratch protection as alternatives 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May make paint imperfections (like minor swirls) more prominent • Vehicle surface preparation and application are more time consuming than wax • Specialized soaps are necessary for removal • Provides less protection than ceramic coatings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Locks in existing swirl marks • Best quality and results require professional-grade products and application • More expensive than waxing • Does not prevent all scratches
